Policies: Independent Study allows an opportunity for a student to stay abreast of instruction during a planned absence, as well as allow our school to maintain the desired level of service by receiving funding for properly executed Independent Study agreements. This opportunity is available for **unavoidable circumstances**, but it does not replace the learning experience derived from attendance at school. The maximum amount of independent days that can be allowed for the school year is 34 days.
